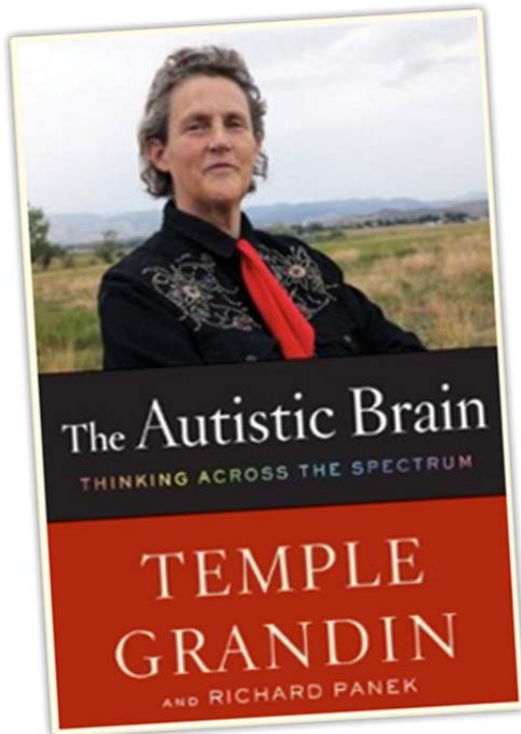


“Today is easier because I know other people in my shoes.” TRCP Parent
